THE NORTH STAR HOUSE, a 10,000-square-foot home, for Arthur DeWint Foote and his family, in 1905.
Part of the history of California's Gold Mining days, the house was meant as a showplace and meeting space for the North Star Mining Company, of which Mr. Foote was the mining manager for over 20 years.
It has been restored over the past 10 years by volunteer labor, with the help of local suppliers and donors.
THE NORTH STAR HISTORIC GARDEN was created in 2018 to commemorate the horticultural pursuits of Mr. Foote and includes many of the plants he used. The project was championed by CPGC member Carole Miller.
TOURS of the house, garden and grounds will be available.
